SHPE OR Professional Chapter Goal

The SHPE Oregon executive board is committed to supporting our Hispanic students and STEM professional community to evolve into a better version of themselves by bringing value-added events/programs. Additionally, the board recognizes the importance of expanding the STEM pipeline and offers volunteering opportunities through local organizations to inspire K-12 students to become the next generation of STEM professionals. Through the various opportunities offered by SHPE Oregon, the board aims to strengthen and develop new relationships to attract new members into the chapter.

SHPE Demographics and Statistics

SHPE OR was founded in 2006 by Trinidad Campos (President), Emilio Cañas (Treasurer), and Jose Garcia (VP) meeting in the Beaverton library. They saw there was a lack of pipelines for diversity initiatives and created the first support structure, mentorship, and resources in the hispanic community in Oregon. Thanks to the efforts of our founders that are co-creators of nationally recognized acclaimed 4-H Tech Wizards model selected for 2015 by the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanic Initiatives, at the first LatinoFest as a Bright Spots in Hispanic education. We have continued the spirit of the original board with the creation of the first SHPE Regional Development Leadership Conference (RLDC) in 2016, and 2022. We continue our mission and vision by our key partnership in the Oregon community.

SHPE Oregon is one of nearly 78 professional chapters in the United States. Our organization is known for its active presence at engineering activities such as Dia de Muerto Vancouver, OMSI, and the Dia del Nino, among others. With collaborative efforts with National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE), Technology Association of Oregon (TOA), and many more non-profit organizations. In addition to its active involvement within the Oregon community, SHPE is known for its networking with industry and the K-12 community and college students in the university chapters. During the 2024 school year, SHPE Oregon was awarded **Chapter of the Year by SHPE National.**

In the past years SHPE Oregon has received;

2015 - 4-H Tech Wizards by the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanic Initiatives

2021 - Blue Chip Award Fall awarded by SHPE National to SHPE OREGON PROFESSIONAL

2022 - Regional Chapter Award awarded by SHPE National to SHPE OREGON PROFESSIONAL

2024 - Chapter of the Year Award awarded by SHPE National to SHPE OREGON PROFESSIONAL




Figure 1. This figure depicts statistics from all members in our region reported to SHPE National.

During 2023-2024, SHPE Oregon Professional had 61 paid members, 113 newsletter subscribers, 535 instagram followers, 448 LinkedIn followers, and 14 facebook followers. The impact SHPE Oregon has on our active members is evident. Our organization's community is composed of diverse backgrounds (see Figures 1, 2, 3). This diversity has allowed us to give our members a first-hand experience of what a

"home away from home" really is regardless of having an engineering degree. By taking advantage of SHPE's resources, our members have attended regional and national conferences, as well as attained internship and research opportunities.

Current Programs

SHPE OR has programs to support our members and community; Professional Development, SHPEtina, Academic, and Community Outreach.

Academic Program

This program is focused on supporting students through events and workshops that will enhance their skills to find Summer internships, their dream jobs, and develop new interviewing skills. The audience includes the three Oregon universities. Under the Academic program, SHPE OR provides sponsorship to students to attend conventions and conferences. At the same time, SHPE OR professional members may serve as mentors when requested by students. One of our staple academic events is Bomba Blast, an opportunity for students (from local universities) and professionals to meet for thirty minutes to have a resume review and/or mock interview.

Professional Development Program

We partner with local mid-career and seasoned STEM professionals who serve as speakers, either to discuss technical topics in which they are subject matter experts or to talk about their STEM journey. Topics include negotiating salaries, career development paths, the importance of mentorship, how to utilize Employee Resources Groups (ERGs) to grow our careers and learn new skills, among many other crucial subjects related to creating a fulfilling and successful career. Under this program, SHPE OR collaborates with local companies for nonprofits to promote their job openings and/or support their DEI initiatives. The objective is to create a link among our recent graduates and professionals and potential employees. We create professional networking events where ERGs leads and professionals (non-members) are invited to chat with our SHPE Familia and share their engineering journey.

SHPEtina Program

Designed to empower Hispanic women to be unapologetically authentic and confident while creating the career path they aspire to. In this program we welcome everyone, but it is tailored for women of color in STEM.

Community Outreach Program

A combination of social networking events to bring our SHPE Familia together and social service to strengthen our bonds with our community. This program offers opportunities to serve in our community, either through STEM educational events targeted for K-12 and high-schoolers, such as Noche de Ciencias, or by supporting local nonprofits in their quest to offer help to those who are most in need. This program supports smaller local organizations dedicated to supporting the educational advancement of Hispanic students.
